Purpose and legal basis of the data processing

Purpose: Traceability of COVID-19 infections;

The legal basis for the processing of data is Article 6 (1) (e) of the GDPR (processing of personal data to protect vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person). This also includes the processing of personal data for the monitoring of epidemics and their spread.

Recipients of the contact data collected

The data collected may only be passed on at the request of the competent health authorities in order to trace possible infection routes.

Storage duration

The contact details shall be **kept** for a period of **one month** and then destroyed.

Your rights with regard to the processing of your data

In your capacity as a data subject, you have the right of access to and the right to correct your personal data that has been collected, as well as the right to have your data deleted after expiry of the retention period toward the Bavarian Landtag. For this purpose, you can contact the Bavarian Landtag using the above-mentioned contact details. Independently of this, the Bavarian Landtag must delete the data after expiry of the above-mentioned retention period.

Above and beyond this, you have a right of appeal to the Bavarian *Land* Commissioner for Data Protection (Art. 77 of the GDPR). You can contact him as follows:
